

PAC Drive Pulpit Talk

Good afternoon:

Thank you for opening your doors and hearts to the mission of PAC – the Pregnancy Aid Clinic!

PAC is a loving pregnancy resource center endorsed by the Archdiocese of Atlanta, with the mission of helping women, men and families facing an unplanned or crisis pregnancy.

By God's grace, we live in a post Roe society and abortion is no longer federally protected.

In Georgia, we are blessed with the LIFE Act, which protects unborn babies who have a heartbeat.

Unfortunately, mothers who are alone, frightened, ill-informed or confused – continue to seek termination prior to six weeks of pregnancy, or even thereafter, by taking abortion-inducing pills or traveling to states that allow for later abortions.

So. We are here today to ask for your generous support to help these venerable women and their children.

Let me share with you the story of a client we recently saved.

Mikhaela was 13 weeks pregnant and filled with uncertainty when she found PAC.

Reeling with emotion following a visit to an abortion clinic – Mikhaela was looking for answers.

She told us “The abortion clinic was dark and depressing and didn't feel right.”

When she heard people praying outside of the clinic, she felt the nudge to re-think her decision.

Scared and confused, Mikhaela left the abortion clinic and walked over to PAC where she met Nancy – one of PAC's client advocates.

Nancy helped Mikhaela work through her concerns with managing an unplanned pregnancy, including the potential of disappointing her own mother.

PAC gave Mikhaela the opportunity to slow down – to learn and discuss options.

And the true life-saving moment was when Mikhaela saw her baby moving during the ultrasound exam.

Baby Maiomi is now six months old. Mikhaela's mom was in fact not disappointed with her – and the two are in love with Maiomi – and thank God for the gift of life.

Unfortunately, many women in crisis pregnancies continue to choose to end their pregnancy through chemical or surgical means.

While proponents of abortion speak openly about a “women’s right to choose” they say nothing about the wounded bodies and souls that abortion leaves behind.

PATH bible studies and retreats help post-abortive women seek healing, grace, and peace.
